**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 11.68, ENTITLED
“HONORARY STREETS,” OF TITLE 11, ENTITLED “VEHICLES
AND TRAFFIC,” OF THE WESTCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE
IN ORDER TO DESIGNATE “DONALD DEVINE WAY”
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF WESTCHESTER**

WHEREAS, Donald P. Devine, born July 14, 1925, having attended St. Francis of Rome Grammar School and St. Ignatius College Prep before serving in the U.S. Army in World War II, is a member of what is known as the “Greatest Generation”; and

WHEREAS, during World War II, Donald served as a First Scout, Rifleman with Company K, 320th Infantry Division, a unit of General Patton’s Third Army in France, and after the war, he remained in the Army Reserves as a Counter Intelligence Agent and as a member of a Special Forces Intelligence Unit, and after 43 years of military service, Donald retired as a Lieutenant Colonel; and

WHEREAS, after Donald returned from the war, he continued his studies at Loyola University Chicago and began his long time career with Dun & Bradstreet. Donald and his wife Elizabeth have been members of Divine Infant Parish and residents of Westchester for over 60 years. Additionally, Donald served as a Village Trustee for four years and spent over 25 years as a Fire and Police Commissioner, during which Donald served as the President of the Illinois Fire & Police Commissioners Association, in 2005 and 2006; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Westchester desire to honor Mr. Donald P. Devine for his dedication and service to the Village of Westchester, by designating a portion of Suffolk Avenue, as “Donald Devine Way”.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Section 11.68.010, entitled “Honorary Streets – Designated,” of Chapter 11.68, entitled “Honorary Streets,” of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic,” is hereby amended as follows:

Chapter 11.68 HONORARY STREETS

11.68.010 Honorary Streets – Designated.

The following streets are designated as honorary streets:

- (a) Honorable John J. Sinda Drive, on Mayfair Avenue, from 31st Street to Canterbury Street
- (b) Honorable Angelo L. Luciano Avenue, on Sunnyside Avenue, from 31st Street to Cermak Road
- (c) Honorable Frederick Wedinger Way, on Wakefield Street, from Wolf Road to Boeger Avenue
- (d) George Zanoni Way, on Becket Avenue, from Carlisle Street to 31st Street.
- (e) Coach Gene Pingatore Way, on Sherwood Avenue, from Robinhood Street to Windsor Drive
- (f) Barbara J. Bailey Way, on Nelson Square, from Nelson Street to Kingston Street.
- (g) Dr. Raymond Albert Way, on Windsor Drive, from Downing Avenue to Mayfair Avenue
- (h) Lucille Perry Way, on Newcastle Avenue, from Canterbury Street to Kent Street.
- (i) Tom & Colette Durkin Way, on Canterbury Street, from Balmoral Avenue to Mannheim Road.
- (j) William (Bill) Ernst Way, on Newcastle Avenue between Devonshire Street and Roosevelt Road.
- (k) Donald Devine Way, on Suffolk Avenue between Dover Street and Cermak Road.

Section 2. The Village’s Public Works Director is hereby authorized and directed to install the appropriate honorary street signage for Donald Devine Way, on Suffolk Avenue, from Dover Street to Cermak Road.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
