**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11.32.150, ENTITLED  
“TRUCK PARKING,” OF THE WESTCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the Village of Westchester (“Village”) find it advisable, necessary and in the best interest of the public to amend Section 11.32.150, entitled “Truck parking,” of Chapter 11.32, entitled “Parking,” of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic,” of the Westchester Municipal Code, of the Westchester Municipal Code, in order to regulate the parking of certain commercial vehicles in residential districts within the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** Paragraph (a) of Section 11.32.150, entitled “Truck parking,” of Chapter 11.32, entitled “Parking,” of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic,” of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

**11.32.150 – Truck parking.**

a) Except as provided herein or in Section 11.32.155 hereinafter, it is unlawful to park any vehicle which is licensed to operate as a truck-tractor, or a semi-trailer, or a trailer, or a truck bearing a class D or higher license classification plate (as provided by the Illinois Vehicle Code), or any tow truck, or any other motor vehicle bearing any class license plate that displays any commercial decals or commercial lettering, or any Second Division vehicle that is operating commercially (e.g. displaying or carrying commercial or industrial equipment), or to permit any such vehicle to remain parked at any time on any street in the Village or on private property in the Village located in a district zoned for residential uses, except for the purpose of making a delivery or a service call for a period of not to exceed thirty minutes, unless prior permission has been obtained from the chief of police or his/her designee.

As an exception to the above, the Village may allow any such commercial vehicle, bearing either a First Division license plate or a Class B, C or D Second Division license plate, to be parked on any street in the Village or on private property in the Village located in a district zoned for residential uses, provided that such vehicle is registered to a resident of the Village of Westchester and the resident/operator first obtains and displays on the windshield a special parking permit decal to be issued by the Village. Only one (1) such special parking permit shall be issued per Village residence.


Such special parking permits shall be issued at the discretion of the Village Manager or his/her designee.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on March 1, 2020, after its passage and approval, as provided by law.
