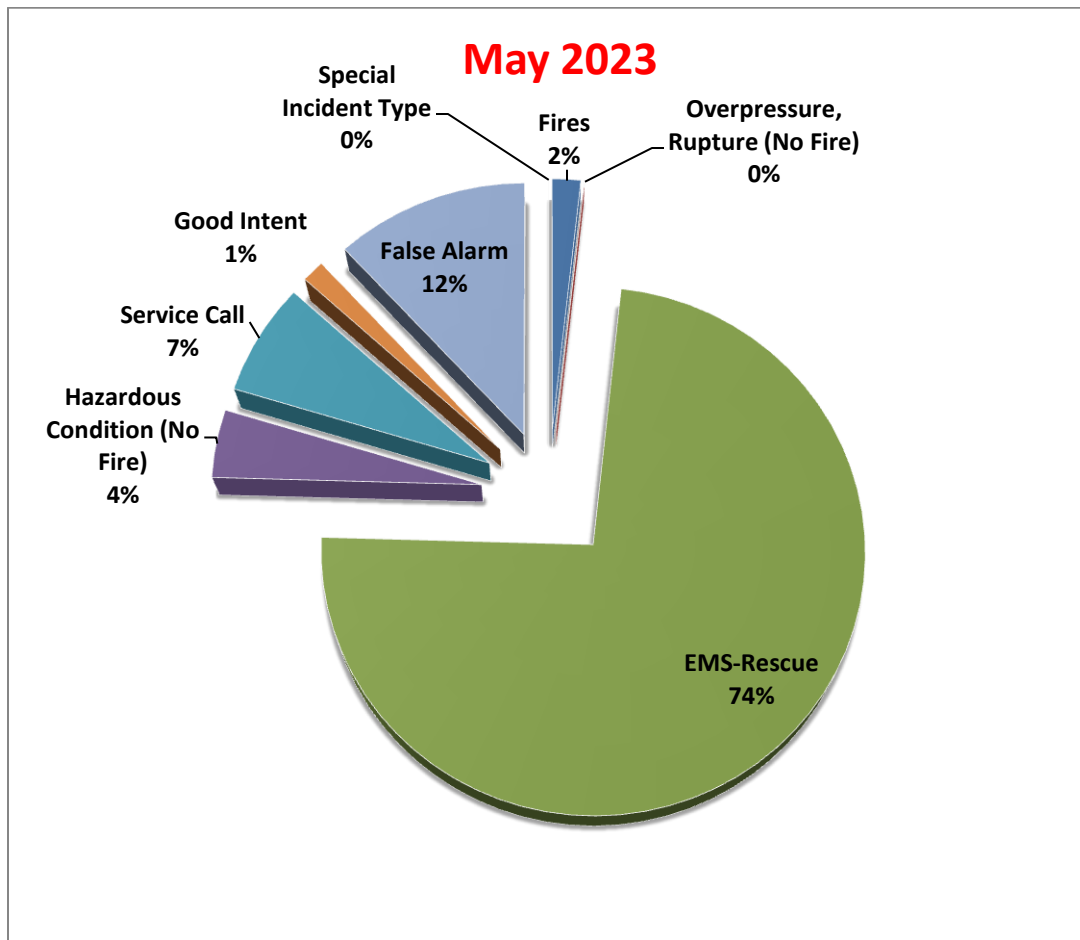

Training

- Lieutenant Biskup and Firefighter Perzyna completed the 40 hour Leadership Development and Decision Making Course in Orland Park through the University of Illinois Fire Service Institute
- Firefighter Homerding completed the 40 hour Vehicle and Machinery Rescue Technician Course at the Northeastern Illinois Public Safety Training Academy.
- All shifts conducted training on rescuing downed firefighters; completed annual mask fit testing; and started in-service training on the new SCBAs.

EMS

- All shifts completed monthly Paramedic continuing education (CEUs). This is required to maintain licensure with the State of Illinois.

Notes

- The application period closed on 5/3/2023. The next Firefighter/Paramedic eligibility test will be on June 4, 2023.
- The department currently has 5 vacancies and 1 firefighter out on long term medical until 2024.
- New Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) and accessories have arrived.
